

## Applique Pantry Jars

*You can make an adorable wall hanging, quilt, or pot holder with this applique! Directions are for wall hanging.*

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### Materials:

Sewing machine in good working order with all accessories, including open toe foot,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot and walking foot

9 - 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares of background fabric (  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd)

Assorted fruit/vegetable/bugs or any novelty fabrics for jars

$\frac{1}{4}$  Yd of Echo quilter's lame in silver or gold for jar caps or gold and silver colored cotton fabrics

1 yd Stitch n' Tear Stabilizer

$\frac{5}{8}$  yd fabric for 2" finished border (cut into 4 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips across WOF) and binding (cut into 4 - 2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips across WOF)

$\frac{3}{4}$  Yd backing and batting

Assorted threads for applique, threads for piecing and quilting

Template plastic and Sharpie pen to trace cap and jar onto.

Basic sewing supplies: scissors, pins, seam gage, seam ripper

1 yd paper backed fusible web

Trace jar and lid onto template plastic.

Trace 9 jars and 9 lids onto paper side of fusible web with Sharpie. Rough cut around, leaving about  $\frac{1}{4}$ " -  $\frac{1}{2}$ " of fusible web outside the lines.

Fuse onto wrong side of jar and lid fabrics. Cut out on line. Fuse jar and lid onto 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares - use this picture for placement.

Applique around jar first, then lid.

Sew jar blocks together, put side borders on, then top and bottom.

Layer, quilt and bind.
